## 2019 Program Details & Enrollment Application

### NOMINATION & APPLICATION PROCESS

The NSLC seeks outstanding high school students from around the world who demonstrate academic excellence and leadership ability. Students are selected to attend the NSLC in one of the following ways:

**School Nomination:** High school educators from across the United States and around the world nominate students based upon academic achievement and leadership qualities. Students nominated by their school are sent an invitation to enroll and are pre-approved for admission based on space availability.

**Alumni Nomination:** NSLC alumni may nominate a student based upon the same criteria as listed above.

**Talent Identification Programs:** Certain students are identified through national student talent identification programs, surveys, and the College Board Student Search Service. These students are recognized for their scholastic achievement and strong interest in the areas of study related to NSLC programs. Qualified students are pre-approved for admission based on space availability.

**Merit Application:** Students who have not received an invitation are invited to apply based on academic merit, extra-curricular accomplishment, and leadership potential. A recommendation from a school counselor, teacher or principal must accompany the application. An educator recommendation form is provided by the NSLC. Merit applications are reviewed by the NSLC Admissions Committee on a rolling basis, so students are advised within two weeks of an admission decision.

### COLLEGE ADMISSIONS

Upon completion of an NSLC program, students receive a Certificate of Achievement and an official program transcript documenting the extensive work performed. Students also receive a letter of recommendation that may be submitted to colleges as part of the admissions process.

### ALUMNI REFERENCES

Alumni references have agreed to speak to students and parents about their experience at the NSLC. Students and parents who wish to speak with alumni references should contact the NSLC Enrollment Office.

### PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Students attending the NSLC must be between the ages of 14-18 and have completed at least one year of high school. Students may attend the NSLC through the summer following their high school graduation. Students who do not meet these requirements should consider our middle school programs. Please contact the Enrollment Office for further details.

### NSLC STAFF

NSLC students are supervised by a highly trained and experienced staff. Staff reside in the dorms and are on-call 24 hours a day. Students are supported by administrative staff as well as small group facilitators or Team Advisors (TAs). Each TA is responsible for guiding a small group of 12-16 students throughout their NSLC experience. The TA staff consists of upper-level undergraduate and graduate students who have backgrounds in the academic focus of the conference, leadership development and residential life. Approximately 85% of the NSLC Team Advisors are NSLC Alumni.

### UNIVERSITIES & RESIDENTIAL LIFE

**The NSLC is a residential program and all students are required to live on campus.** Students are housed in single, double, triple or quad dorm rooms. Most meals during the program are eaten in campus dining facilities. Linens are provided.

### DRESS CODE

For the majority of the conference, students will wear business casual or casual attire. For a few events each session, such as guest speakers or facility visits, students will be required to wear professional attire (coat and tie for males, suit/slacks and blouse or dress for females). A packing checklist will be provided online prior to the conference.

### EMERGENCY MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

The *Student & Parent Agreement* that must be signed by each student and parent prior to participation in an NSLC program includes an Emergency Medical Authorization. This authorization states that in the event the student becomes ill, is injured or requires emergency or other medical treatment while at the NSLC, the student and parent authorize and give full permission to the NSLC, at its discretion, to place the student in a hospital or in the care of a healthcare provider. 24-hour medical treatment is available. Cost of any medical treatment is the responsibility of the student.

While not required, the NSLC strongly recommends students have medical insurance when attending their program. The optional *Student Protection Plan* provides limited coverage for medical expenses incurred due to an illness or injury that occurs while at the NSLC.

### TRANSPORTATION

Students are responsible for transportation to and from the program. The NSLC offers airport pick-up and drop-off service from select local airports for \$40.00-\$80.00 each way depending upon airport. More information on this service is available on the NSLC website. *Note: Students requesting transportation to/from the airport must arrive and depart within specific times. Please do not make travel arrangements before receiving your acceptance. NSLC does not coordinate unaccompanied minors (UMR); please verify airline policies to avoid UMR designations.*

## INCLUDED IN TUITION

Program tuition includes housing, all on-campus meals, course materials, academic expenses, and activities. Tuition also includes chartered, air-conditioned motor coaches for off-campus briefings and tours. *Note: Students should bring spending money for souvenirs, laundry, and a few off-campus meals during field trips and tours. Students will be held responsible for damage to rooms and lost room keys.*

## PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

A tuition deposit must be submitted at the time of application. NSLC provides two payment options. Students may choose to pay in full when applying or agree to a monthly payment plan. Failure to submit payment by the due dates indicated within the payment plan schedule may result in cancellation of enrollment.

## PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIPS AND FUNDRAISING INFORMATION

## REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

All cancellations must be submitted in writing (email is acceptable). Registrations occurring on or before May 1, 2019 may be canceled within 30 days of registration date without incurring a cancellation fee. The following cancellation fees apply to all NSLC enrollments:

By April 1, 2019	\$350 <i>\$500 for 18-day programs</i>
Between April 2 and May 1, 2019	\$500 <i>\$750 for 18-day programs</i>
May 2, 2019 or later	100% of tuition paid

NSLC will refund all tuition paid minus the cancellation fee listed above. **No refunds will be given on or after May 2, 2019.** If an application is rejected or if space is not available, all payments will be refunded in full.

## STUDENT PROTECTION PLAN

Preparing to attend the NSLC should include protecting yourself from unfortunate occurrences that may threaten to interfere with even the best-laid plans. The *Student Protection Plan*, developed to meet the needs of NSLC attendees, includes a broad range of travel protection. In the event that you become unexpectedly ill or injured before or during your trip, the plan will reimburse you for penalties that may be assessed due to cancellation or for the unused portion of your conference should it be interrupted for a covered reason. In addition, the plan covers minor inconveniences like lost or delayed baggage as well as more serious problems such as an unexpected illness or injury requiring emergency evacuation back to your home. This insurance is highly recommended, but may be declined by marking the appropriate box on the enrollment application. A comprehensive Code of Conduct form, which details guidelines for behavior and prohibits possession of such substances as drugs, alcohol, and tobacco will be available on your myNSLC portal (login information to be provided by email upon acceptance to the NSLC). We understand that this form and other required forms must be signed in order to participate in the NSLC. We further understand that failure to abide by this code of conduct may result in immediate dismissal, return home at own expense, and forfeiture of all tuition paid. We understand that the NSLC is a residential program and all students are required to live on campus.

We understand that applications from qualified students are processed in the order received and that applications may exceed available spaces. We understand that spaces are limited and we may be placed on a waitlist. We understand that this is an application for participation in the Program and enrollment is contingent upon approval by NSLC, in its discretion. If not accepted, all money paid will be returned. We understand that payments must be made in accordance with the payment option selected above or this enrollment may be subject to cancellation without refund. We understand the NSLC refund policy as outlined below. A faxed or emailed copy of this document shall be binding as an original.

**REFUND POLICY:** All cancellations must be submitted in writing (email is acceptable). Registrations occurring on or before May 1, 2019 may be canceled within 30 days of registration date without incurring a cancellation fee. The following cancellation fees apply to all NSLC enrollments: If canceled by April 1, 2019 a cancellation fee of \$350 applies (\$500 for 18-day programs). If cancelled between April 2 and May 1, 2019 a \$500 cancellation fee applies (\$750 for 18-day programs). Cancellations made on or after May 2, 2019 will be subject to a cancellation fee of 100% of tuition paid. NSLC will refund all tuition paid minus the cancellation fee as indicated. No refunds will be given on or after May 2, 2019. If an application is rejected or if space is not available, all deposits/payments will be refunded in full. **Note: Student protection plan fees for accepted students are non-refundable.**
